

Distribution box lb distance from ground



Overview

In order to facilitate the maintenance or adjustment of the distribution board, the electrical components in the box must be between 0. All wiring terminals shall be located at least 0. 2m above the ground to facilitate wire removal. Generally, distribution boxes can be divided into three levels of secondary protection, that is, three levels of distribution boxes: general. In homes, the best height for installation is about 1. 5 meters from the floor — it's easy to reach and out of children's reach. Leave enough space around the box for air to flow and for future. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. Grounding of the units: Attach a ground wire from one of. According to the "Code for Acceptance of Construction Quality of Building Electrical Engineering" GB50303-2002, the vertical distance between the bottom surface of the fixed stainless steel enclosure ip67 and the ground should be greater than 1.
