Overview

FC fiber pigtails take advantage of the metal housing of FC optical connectors, which contain a threaded structure and high-precision ceramic ferrules. They are widely used in various scenarios due to their robust design and reliable performance. The core diameters ($9\ \mu\text{m}$ vs. $5\ \mu\text{m}$) are fundamentally incompatible—attempting to splice or connect them results in massive insertion loss (often $10+$ dB) that will fail every optical power budget test.
