Overview

The term "6-core" refers to the number of individual optical fibers within the cable. Unlike traditional single-core or dual-core cables, a 6-core fiber optic cable provides six independent channels for data transmission. This small diameter core, typically around 9 microns in diameter, allows only one mode of light to pass through, resulting in a narrower beam of light. Cat 6 must meet more stringent specifications for crosstalk and system noise than Cat 5 and Cat 5e.
