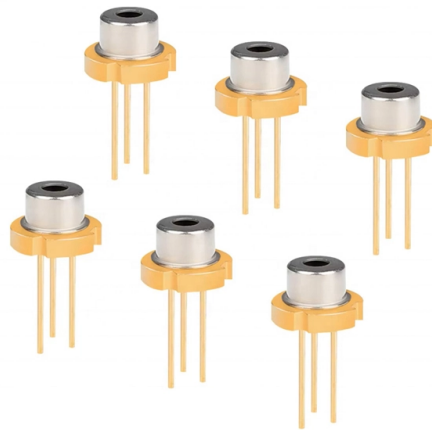


How to connect a fiber optic transceiver to a splitter
