

How to connect the grounding wire and grounding rod of the distribution box



Overview

Attach a ground wire from one of the threaded studs (A) at the bottom of the housing, to the mounting plate (B). The ground resistance between all system parts shall be $< 1 \Omega$. Power from factory ground must be installed by a qualified electrician. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Good equipment grounding ensures personnel safety. Most North American distribution systems have a neutral that acts as a return conductor and as an equipment ground. A ground rod, also known as an earthing rod, grounding rod or ground electrode, is a long, slender metal rod that is typically made of materials like copper or steel. While traditionally this has been connected to 2 ground rods, in a new building it is recommended, and often required, that it be connected to an Ufer ground, which is basically a ground rod in the concrete. Here are the steps on how to ground a power distribution box: 1.
