

How to remove the grounding cable from the distribution box



Overview

Remove Phase Connections First: Using a hot stick, remove grounding clamps from each phase (A, B, C) in reverse order, starting with the closest phase to the ground point. Grounding cable set (rated for fault current, e. Each DISTRIBUTION BOX and controller must be grounded. 26 mm² (10 AWG) ground wire must be used, and in all other markets a 6 mm² must be used. Problem is, if there is a main ahead of this panel, with separate ground and internal bond, then that ground from that main disconnect has to go to your ground terminals separately and that green bond screw would. **Safety of Personnel:** By safely channeling fault currents into the ground, proper grounding helps to reduce the risk of electric shock to personnel.
