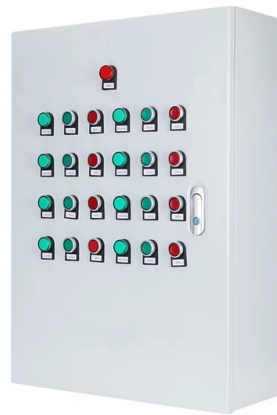


Is it safe to leave a cover on a home electrical distribution box
