UL508A contains two important requirements to consider when applying power distribution blocks. Spacing of 1" through air, 2" over surface (at 600V) is required when used in a feeder circuit (that's everything ahead of or on the line side of the final branch circuit overcurrent. Choose the right box based on environment (indoor/outdoor), load capacity, and durability. Check for proper IP/NEMA ratings and material quality. Ensure safe placement: install in. When applying Power Distribution Blocks (PDBs), there are various requirements that shall be satisfied, based upon different UL Standards, the NEC®, and the specific application. Home distribution boxes typically handle single-phase power supplies and contain 6 to 24 circuits. three phase lines a, B and C (generally yellow, green and red), one zero line (light blue) and one ground line (yellow with green stripes). Put them after the main breaker. Test your SPDs every six months.
