This 17,200 Km long fiber optic cable was built by MTN along with a consortium of 16 leading international telecom carriers. While submarine communications cables are used to connect countries and continents to the Internet, terrestrial fibre optic cables are used to extend this connectivity to landlocked countries or to urban centers within a country.
