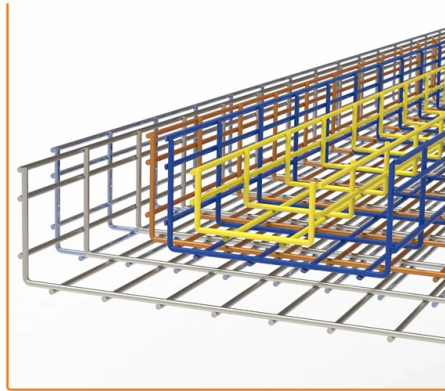


What is the process of listing cybersecurity devices



Overview

Device enumeration is the process by which an operating system or network scans, detects, and identifies all hardware devices connected to a system or network. What is the process to get a commercial product CSfC-listed?

Vendors who wish to have their products eligible as CSfC components of a composed, layered information assurance solution must build their products in accordance with the applicable US Government approved Protection Profile (s) and submit. An application whitelist is a list of applications and application components that are authorized for use in an organization. This helps to stop the execution of malware. This site contains the Security Technical Implementation Guides and Security Requirements Guides for the Department of Defense (DOD) information technology systems as mandated by DODI 8500. This guidance bridges the gap between the National Institute of Standards and Technology Special. For OT environments, a key part of creating an asset inventory is developing an OT taxonomy: a management, and incident response by classifying assets based on function and criticality. This is typically accomplished by maintaining a list of known malicious actors or dangerous IP addresses and blocking all traffic originating from those IP addresses.
