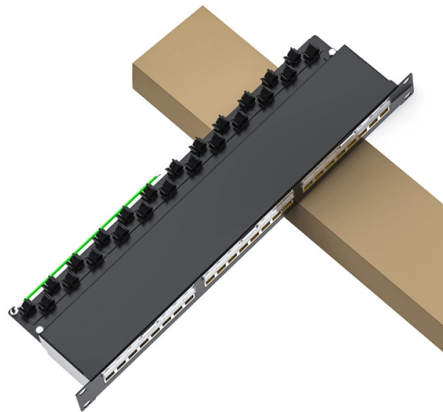


What type of fiber optic cable is used for long-distance transport
