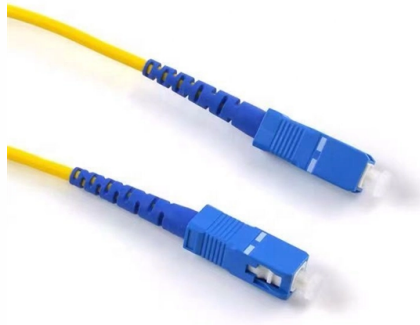


Why did Huijue s Congo optical cable factory shut down
